Novice Junior Class: For Boys and Girls who are at least 9 years old and under 12 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have not won three First Place awards with competition present in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

Novice Intermediate Class: For Boys and Girls who are at least 12 years old and under 15 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have not won three First Place awards with competition present in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

Novice Senior Class: For Boys and Girls who are at least 15 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have not won three First Place awards with competition present in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

Open Junior Class: For Boys and Girls who are at least 9 years old and under 12 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have won three First Place awards with competition present in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

Open Intermediate Class: For Boys and Girls who are at least 12 years old and under 15 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have won three First Place awards with competition present in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

Open Senior Class: For Boys and Girls who are at least 15 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have won three First Place awards with competition present in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

Each dog handled in a Junior Showmanship Class must be entered in one of the Breed or Obedience Classes at the show, or must be entered for Junior Showmanship only. However, a dog may be substituted. Such substitution must be accompanied by an official AKC entry form. All such substitutions must be made one half-hour prior to the judging of any Junior Showmanship Classes at the show. Each dog must be owned or co-owned by the Junior Handler or by the Junior Handler's father, mother, brother, sister, uncle, aunt, grandfather or grandmother, including step and half relations or by a member of the Junior Handler's household. Every dog entered for Junior Showmanship must be eligible to compete in Dog Shows or in Obedience Trials. BITCHES IN SEASON ARE NOT ELIGIBLE. A dog that has been excused or disqualified by a Breed Judge or by a Bench Show Committee may still be handled in Junior Showmanship if eligible to compete in Obedience Trials. A dog that has been rejected, dismissed, or excused by the Veterinarian for the protection of the other dogs at the show or for the protection of the dog excused may not be handled in Junior Showmanship.

Junior Handlers who win a third Novice Class with competition present after the closing of entries for a show may transfer their entry from the Novice Class to the Open Class provided that this transfer is made by the Superintendent at least one half-hour prior to the scheduled start of any regular conformation judging or one half-hour to the scheduled start of Junior Showmanship judging at the show, whichever is earlier.

Winning of first place in an Open Class at this show may qualify or count toward qualification for entry in certain future limited Junior Showmanship Classes. For information on eligibility requirements for limited Junior Showmanship Classes which have been approved to date by AKC, write to the American Kennel Club, Show Plans, PO Box 900051, Raleigh, NC 27675-9051.

Dogs must be 6 months of age or older and wear a well-fitting 6 ft. buckle or slip collar made of leather, fabric or chain. Owner/handler must show county license or proof of rabies vaccination and bring dog's brush or comb. Registration at Catalog Table.

For the Therapy Dog Evaluation, only flat buckle collar or harness is allowed.

ADDITIONAL RULES

1. Entries must reach the Superintendent, Jack Bradshaw, 5434 East Olympic Boulevard, Los Angeles CA, 90022, by Noon, Wednesday, April 15, 2009 PDT. Fees should accompany entries. This club and/or its superintendent assumes no responsibility for wrong or incomplete information given on the entry blank by the owner or agent of the owner. This club and its superintendents assume no responsibility for the owner or owner's agents entering a dog in a class in which the dog is not eligible to compete, or for entering the same dog twice.
2. Returned Checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. The Superintendent will add a collection fee to the amount of each returned check and declined credit card. Subsequent returned checks for the same exhibitors may result in their being put on a CASH ONLY basis. The returned check or declined credit card MUST BE MADE GOOD by cash or money order BEFORE the dog will be allowed in the ring.
3. Exhibitors' Identification tickets and judging programs will be mailed to the address given on the entry blank. If not received within a reasonable time prior to the show, notify the superintendent. Tickets returned by the Post Office marked 'undeliverable' will be held at the Superintendent's Office. PLEASE BRING YOUR IDENTIFICATION TICKETS TO THE SHOW.
4. During the hours of judging owners are to be on call, and have their dogs ready to bring into the judging ring promptly, in order that the judging will not be delayed. Dogs need only be present for their judging. Dogs not needed for further judging may be excused. It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to have his dog ready to be shown and at the entrance of the judging ring when the steward calls for the class. Owners of dogs or the handlers of the dogs alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging rings. This means it is not the responsibility of the ring steward, nor of any agent of the show-giving club to locate any dog, its owner or handler, when the dog's presence is needed in a judging ring. It should be understood by every exhibitor and handler that waiting for dogs to be brought into the ring is a courtesy extended to the owner or handler of the dog. There is no rule of this club nor of The American Kennel Club that requires a judge to wait for an owner or handler to bring his dog into the ring. Show hours 7 a.m. to 8 p.m.
5. Trophies and prizes will be awarded in the judging ring before the completion of the judging of the breed and the superintendent's office advised at once, in the event of any discrepancy. All trophies must be claimed the day of the show. None will be mailed.
6. Exhibitors are admonished to make themselves familiar with the agreement of the American Kennel Club, referred to on the reverse side of the entry blanks that accompany this premium list. Rule books are available at the Superintendent's table at the shows or may be obtained from the A.K.C., PO Box 900051, Raleigh, NC 27675-9051.
7. The club, its superintendents or their employees will not be responsible for the loss or damage to any dog exhibited, whether the result of accident or other causes and in addition assumes no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by an exhibitor or handler. It is distinctly understood that every dog is on the show premises.
8. No grooming tables, pens or exhibitors setups will be allowed in the aisles and all grooming must be done away from the judging ring in areas specified by the club.
9. Entry fees shall NOT be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, sick, lame, excused by veterinarian or judge, barred from competition by action of the Bench Show Committee, or because the dog is ineligible to compete due to being entered incorrectly. There is no refund of entry fee for duplicate entry. There will be a \$2.00 fee charged for cancellation of entry prior to closing of entries.
10. There is no provision offered for unentered dogs at this show.
11. Declination of Entries. The Rio Hondo Kennel Club may decline any entries for cause and may refuse to receive or may remove any dog on account of disease, viciousness or other causes, and no one shall have any claim or recourse against the Kennel Club or any official thereof.
12. If, because of riots, civil disturbances or other acts beyond the control of the management, it is impossible to open or complete the show, no refund of entry will be made.
13. Do not leave any dogs in closed vehicles.
14. A Recording Fee of 50 cents, an Event Services Fee of \$3.00, and a \$3.00 Rally Fee will be required at any Licensed or Member Club Show, Obedience Trial or Tracking Test. These fees are to be collected by the Show-giving Club and paid to the American Kennel Club. (American Kennel Club Rule, Chapter 11, Section 2.)
15. Dogs which according to their owners' records have completed the requirements for a championship after the closing of entries for the show but whose championships are unconfirmed, may be transferred from one of the regular classes to the Best of Breed or Variety Competition, provided this transfer is made by the Superintendent at least one half hour prior to the start of the earliest Conformation judging at the Show.
16. Junior handlers who win a third Novice Class after the Closing of entries for a show may transfer their entry from the Novice Class to the Open Class provided that this transfer is made by the Superintendent at least one half hour prior to the scheduled start of the earliest conformation judging or one half hour prior to the scheduled start of Junior Showmanship judging at the Show, whichever is earlier.
17. Dogs which according to their owners' records have earned an obedience or rally title after the closing of entries for the show may be moved up to the next class, provided this transfer is made in writing and presented to the superintendent at least 30 minutes prior to the start of each trial.
18. No practicing is allowed in rings at any time.

PARKING

Parking for the Rio Hondo Kennel Club weekend is a privilege granted by the club and Cal Poly Pomona. All regulations will be strictly enforced. All parking is on asphalt and will be clearly marked.

DAY OF SHOW PARKING

SATURDAY AND SUNDAY: Autos and vans may park for a fee of \$5.00 per day. All must observe the marking and will be directed by attendants.

Unloading Zones will be provided. You must leave your lights on, and may park for 15 minutes maximum, after which you will be subject to citation and/or disciplinary action.

OVERNIGHT PARKING & MOTORHOMES

Parking will be \$80.00 for the weekend. Paved parking on the Showgrounds will be available. Gates will open at 5:00 p.m. on Friday and close at 11:00 p.m. Gates will reopen at 6:00 a.m. and close at 7:00 a.m. on Saturday and be available only after Best in Show and reopen on Sunday from 6:00 a.m. to 7:00 a.m.

Parking reservations will be assigned in the order received. All reservations received after the limit is reached will be returned. If you wish to park next to a particular party, reservations must be received in the same envelope and must arrive together.

Exhibitors will be permitted to set up a space in the grooming area and return on Saturday morning. Spaces may not be saved for friends.

Each vehicle will receive a validation notice as they enter the reserved parking area. This notice must be prominently displayed in the front window of the vehicle. Any vehicle found without a validation notice will be towed at the owner's expense.

Parking is a privilege extended by the Rio Hondo Kennel Club and Cal Poly and will be permanently withdrawn from those exhibitors who do not follow the rules, regulations or instructions of the Club and the Officers on duty. Rudeness or abusive language will not be tolerated.

Pens and crates shall not exceed the length of the parking space and a center fire lane aisle must be kept open between rows. All automobiles must be parked within assigned spaces.

All units must be self-contained. Electrical or water hookups are not available and discharge of grey water or sanitary tanks will not be permitted. Exhibitors will be responsible for cleanup of their parking spaces. Trash containers will be placed at the exit of the parking area. PLEASE, NO GENERATORS AFTER 11:00 P.M.

Overnight handicapped parking will not be provided. Day of show auto handicapped parking will be provided; however, grooming in this area is prohibited.

An unloading area will be provided.

Firearms and alcoholic beverages are not allowed on the Cal Poly Campus.
