RAMP - At the discretion of the judge, the following breeds may be judged on a ramp: Clumber Spaniels, Field Spaniels, Sussex Spaniels, Welsh Springer Spaniels, Irish Terriers, Kerry Blue Terriers, Soft Coated Wheaten Terriers, Staffordshire Bull Terriers, Chinese Shar-Pei, Chow Chows, Keeshonden, and Polish Lowland Sheepdogs. Whippets may be judged on the ground, on a table or on a ramp. Basset Hounds and Bulldogs are expected to be judged on a ramp. For the judging of juniors the ramp may be used at the discretion of the judge for the ramp breeds. Ramps may be used in emergency situations to judge any breed. (In all but emergency situations, the exhibitor has no recourse. In an emergency situation, where use of a ramp is not indicated in the premium list, an exhibitor has the option of withdrawing their entry and receiving a refund.)

This will be done after Best of Breed judging unless the Best Puppy award is automatic. Example: An entry from the puppy classes is awarded Best of Winners or Best of Breed. Only dogs or bitches undefeated in a puppy class are eligible for Best Puppy Competition. If the first place winner is not present the second place winner **may not compete**.

All Best Puppies will compete in their respective Best Puppy Groups. All Best in Group puppies will compete for Best Puppy in Show.

THERE WILL BE NO ADDITIONAL ENTRY FEE FOR THIS COMPETITION. PUPPIES MUST BE ENTERED IN THE REGULAR 6 TO 9 MONTH OR 9 TO 12 MONTH PUPPY CLASS TO BE ELIGIBLE FOR THE BEST PUPPY COMPETITION.

SATURDAY - BEST BRED-BY-EXHIBITOR COMPETITION

There will be a Best Bred-By-Exhibitor Competition. Competition will be for Best Bred-By-Exhibitor in each breed or variety, Best Bred-By-Exhibitor in Group (placements 1 through 4) and Best Bred-By-Exhibitor in Show.

RULES:

The same rules that apply to eligibility to compete in the regular Bred-By-Exhibitor classes apply to eligibility to compete in Best Bred-By-Exhibitor in Breed or Variety, Group and Best in Show. During the course of regular breed judging, the assigned judge will select a Best Bred-By-Exhibitor from the class winners of the Bred-By-Exhibitor classes. This will be done after Best of Breed judging unless the Best Bred-By-Exhibitor award is automatic. Example: An entry from the Bred-By-Exhibitor classes is awarded Best of Winners or Best of Breed. Only dogs or bitches undefeated in a Bred-By-Exhibitor class are eligible for Best Bred-By-Exhibitor Competition. If the first place winner is not present the second place winner **may not compete**.

All Best Bred-By-Exhibitor Dog/Bitches will compete in their respective Bred-By-Exhibitor Groups. All Best in Group Bred-By-Exhibitor winners will compete for Best Bred-By-Exhibitor in Show.

THERE WILL BE NO ADDITIONAL ENTRY FEE FOR THIS COMPETITION. ONLY ENTRIES IN THE REGULAR BRED BY EXHIBITOR CLASSES ARE ELIGIBLE FOR THE BEST BRED-BY-EXHIBITOR COMPETITION.

SUNDAY - BEST VETERAN COMPETITION

There will be a Veteran Competition. Competition will be for Best Veteran in each breed or variety, Best Veteran in Group (placements 1 through 4) and Best Veteran in Show.

RULES:

The same rules that apply to eligibility to compete in the regular Veteran classes apply to eligibility to compete in Best Veteran in Breed or Variety, Group and Best in Show. During the course of regular breed judging, the assigned judge will select a Best Veteran. This will be done after Best of Breed judging unless the Best Veteran award is automatic. Example: An entry from the Veteran classes is awarded Best of Breed. Only dogs or bitches undefeated in a Veteran class are eligible for Best Veteran Competition. If the first place winner is not present the second place winner **may not compete**.

All Best Veteran Dog/Bitches will compete in their respective Veteran Groups. All Best in Group Veteran winners will compete for Best Veteran in Show.

THERE WILL BE NO ADDITIONAL ENTRY FEE FOR THIS COMPETITION. ONLY ENTRIES IN THE VETERAN CLASSES ARE ELIGIBLE FOR THE BEST VETERAN COMPETITION.

JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP COMPETITION

Novice Junior Class: For Boys and Girls who are at least 9 years old and under 12 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have not won three First Place awards with competition present in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

Novice Intermediate Class: For Boys and Girls who are at least 12 years old and under 15 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have not won three First Place awards with competition present in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

Novice Senior Class: For Boys and Girls who are at least 15 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have not won three First Place awards with competition present in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

Open Junior Class: For Boys and Girls who are at least 9 years old and under 12 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have won three First Place awards with competition present in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

Open Intermediate Class: For Boys and Girls who are at least 12 years old and under 15 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have won three First Place awards with competition present in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

Open Senior Class: For Boys and Girls who are at least 15 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have won three First Place awards with competition present in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

Master Class: This class will be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years on the day of the show, and who have won the 10 first place wins in an Open class with competition to be eligible to enter the Limited Class Competition. The calendar for this class will be November 1 - October 31 of the following year. All Juniors meeting the criteria for this class are required to enter the Master Class and may change their entry the day of the show if entries have already closed. Once the eligibility time frame for that year has passed all participants return to the Open Class to compete for the following year.

Each dog handled in a Junior Showmanship Class must be entered in one of the Breed or Obedience Classes at the show, or must be entered for Junior Showmanship only. However, a dog may be substituted. Such substitution must be accompanied by an official AKC entry form. All such substitutions must be made one half-hour prior to the judging of any Junior Showmanship Classes at the show. Each dog must be owned or co-owned by the Junior Handler or by the Junior Handler's father, mother, brother, sister, uncle, aunt, grandfather or grandmother, including step and half relations or by a member of the Junior Handler's household. Every dog entered for Junior Showmanship must be eligible to compete in Dog Shows or in Obedience Trials. BITCHES IN SEASON ARE NOT ELIGIBLE. A dog that has been excused or disqualified by a Breed Judge or by a Bench Show Committee may still be handled in Junior Showmanship if eligible to compete in Obedience Trials. A dog that has been rejected, dismissed, or excused by the Veterinarian for the protection of the other dogs at the show or for the protection of the dog excused may not be handled in Junior Showmanship.

Junior Handlers who win a third Novice Class with competition present after the closing of entries for a show may transfer their entry from the Novice Class to the Open Class provided that this transfer is made by the Superintendent at least one half-hour prior to the scheduled start of any regular conformation judging or one half-hour prior to the scheduled start of Junior Showmanship judging at the show, whichever is earlier.

Winning of first place in an Open Class at this show may qualify or count toward qualification for entry in certain future limited Junior Showmanship Classes. For information on eligibility requirements for limited Junior Showmanship Classes which have been approved to date by AKC go online at www.akc.org

Junior Handler's must include their AKC Junior Handler identification number on the entry blank.

RV Spaces with and without electrical power service will be in adjacent areas, but will be separated. These spaces will be an equal distance from the show rings.

Black/Grey Water Tank pump-out and water refill service will be available – see the following sections.

Dogs must not be left out after 10:00pm; the University of Phoenix Stadium provides security throughout the night, and dogs left out overnight can become a disturbance when the guards are patrolling the aisles.

ADDITIONAL RULES

1. Entries must reach the Superintendent, Jack Bradshaw, 5434 East Olympic Boulevard, Los Angeles CA, 90022, by Noon, Wednesday, March 21, 2012 PDT. Fees should accompany entries. This club and its superintendents assume no responsibility for the owner or owner's agents entering a dog in a class in which the dog is not eligible to compete, or for entering the same dog twice.
2. Returned Checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. The Superintendent will add a collection fee to the amount of each returned check and declined credit card. Subsequent returned checks for the same exhibitors may result in their being put on a CASH ONLY basis. The returned check or declined credit card must be made good by cash or money order before the dog will be allowed in the ring.
3. Exhibitors' identification tickets and wristbands, and judging programs will be mailed to the address given on the entry blank. If not received within a reasonable time prior to the show, notify the superintendent. Tickets returned by the Post Office marked 'undeliverable' will be held at the Superintendent's Office. PLEASE BRING YOUR IDENTIFICATION TICKETS TO THE SHOW. YOUR WRISTBAND WILL BE REQUIRED FOR ACCESS TO THE SHOW FLOOR.
4. During the hours of judging owners are to be on call, and have their dogs ready to bring into the judging ring promptly, in order that the judging will not be delayed. Dogs need only be present for their judging. Dogs not needed for further judging may be excused. It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to have his dog ready to be shown and at the entrance of the judging ring when the steward calls for the class. Owners of dogs or the handlers of the dogs alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging rings. This means it is not the responsibility of the ring steward, or of any agent of the show-giving club to locate any dog, its owner or handler, when the dog's presence is needed in a judging ring. It should be understood by every exhibitor and handler that waiting for dogs to be brought into the ring is a courtesy extended to the owner or handler of the dog. There is no rule of this club nor of The American Kennel Club that requires a judge to wait for an owner or handler to bring his dog into the ring. Show hours 7 a.m. to 7:00 p.m.
5. Trophies and prizes will be awarded in the judging ring before the completion of the judging of the breed and the superintendent's office advised at once, in the event of any discrepancy. All trophies must be claimed the day of the show. None will be mailed.
6. Exhibitors are admonished to make themselves familiar with the agreement of the American Kennel Club, referred to on the reverse side of the entry blanks that accompany this premium list. Rulebooks are available online at www.akc.org
7. The club, its superintendents or their employees will not be responsible for the loss or damage to any dog exhibited, whether the result of accident or other causes and in addition assumes no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by an exhibitor or handler. It is distinctly understood that every dog at this show is in the care and custody and control of his owner or handler during the entire time the dog is on the show premises.
8. Grooming tables, pens and exhibitors setups will be allowed only in areas specified by the club. Due to the limited space available, exercise pens WILL NOT be allowed in the UNRESERVED grooming area.
9. Entry fees shall NOT be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, sick, lame, excused by veterinarian or judge, barred from competition by action of the Bench Show Committee, or because the dog is ineligible to compete due to being entered incorrectly. There is no refund of entry fee for duplicate entry. There will be a \$2.00 fee charged for cancellation of entry prior to closing of entries.
10. There is no provision offered for unentered dogs at this show. PUPPIES UNDER THE AGE OF SIX MONTHS ARE STRICTLY PROHIBITED FROM ENTRY INTO THE BUILDING.
11. Declination of Entries. Kachina Kennel Club and Arrowhead Kennel Club may decline any entries for cause and may refuse to receive or may remove any dog on account of disease, viciousness or other causes, and no one shall have any claim or recourse against the Kennel Club or any official thereof.
12. If, because of riots, civil disturbances or other acts beyond the control of the management, it is impossible to open or complete the show, no refund of entry will be made.
13. Do not leave any dogs in closed vehicles.
14. Dogs which according to their owners' records have completed the requirements for a championship after the closing of entries for the show but whose championships are unconfirmed, may be transferred from one of the regular classes to the Best of Breed or Variety Competition, provided this transfer is made by the Superintendent at least one half hour prior to the start of the earliest Conformation judging at the Show.
15. Junior Handlers who win a third Novice Class after the Closing of entries for a show may transfer their entry from the Novice Class to the Open Class provided that this transfer is made by the Superintendent at least one half-hour prior to the scheduled start of the earliest conformation judging or one half-hour prior to the scheduled start of Junior Showmanship judging at the Show, whichever is earlier.
16. Dogs which according to their owners' records have earned an obedience title after the closing of entries for the show may be moved up to the next class, provided this transfer is made in writing and presented to the superintendent at least 30 minutes prior to the start of each trial.
17. Due to the confined space, flexi-leads are not allowed inside of the stadium building.
18. No practicing allowed in rings at any time.
19. Parents and/or guardians are responsible for the actions of their children.

PREFACE: The sport of purebred dog competitive events dates prior to 1884, the year of AKC's birth. Shared values of those involved in the sport include principles of sportsmanship. They are practiced in all sectors of our sport: conformation, performance and companion. Many believe that these principles of sportsmanship are the prime reason why our sport has thrived for over one hundred years. With the belief that it is useful to periodically articulate the fundamentals of our sport, this code is presented.

- Sportsmen respect the history, traditions and integrity of the sport of purebred dogs.
- Sportsmen commit themselves to values of fair play, honesty, courtesy, and vigorous competition, as well as winning and losing with grace.
- Sportsmen refuse to compromise their commitment and obligation to the sport of purebred dogs by injecting personal advantage or consideration into their decisions or behavior.
- The sportsman judge judges only on the merits of the dogs and considers no other factors.
- The sportsman judge or exhibitor accepts constructive criticism.
- The sportsman exhibitor declines to enter or exhibit under a judge where it might reasonably appear that the judge's placements could be based on something other than the merits of the dogs.
- The sportsman exhibitor refuses to compromise the impartiality of a judge.
- The sportsman respects the AKC bylaws, rules, regulations and policies governing the sport of purebred dogs.
- Sportsmen find that vigorous competition and civility are not inconsistent and are able to appreciate the merit of their competition and the effort of competitors.
- Sportsmen welcome, encourage and support newcomers to the sport.
- Sportsmen will deal fairly with all those who trade with them.
- Sportsmen are willing to share honest and open appraisals of both the strengths and weaknesses of their breeding stock.
- Sportsmen spurn any opportunity to take personal advantage of positions offered or bestowed upon them.
- Sportsmen always consider as paramount the welfare of their dog.
- Sportsmen refuse to embarrass the sport, the American Kennel Club, or themselves while taking part in the sport.

If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e. age division, color division, weight division.
4. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his name.
