## **SWEEPSTAKES ~ PUPPY & VETERAN**

**PUPPY SWEEPSTAKES ELIGIBILITY:** The Sweepstakes is open to all Ibizan Hounds, who, on the day of the show, will be at least 6 months and under 18 months of age. All dogs entered in Sweepstakes MUST BE entered in a Regular Class at this show. Entry fee is \$18.00 in addition to the Regular Entry Fee. Entry in the Sweepstakes must be made at the same time and on the same entry form as for the Regular Classes. Write SWEEPSTAKES in the "Additional Class" space and state the AGE DIVISION.

### **CLASSIFICATION ~ PUPPY SWEEPSTAKES CLASSES**

The following age division classes are offered for both Dogs and Bitches:  
*6 months and under 9 months; 9 months and under 12 months; 12 months and under 18 months*

**VETERAN SWEEPSTAKES ELIGIBILITY:** The Veteran Sweepstakes is open to all Ibizan Hounds, who, on the day of the show, will be at least 7 years of age or older. Dogs entered in Veteran Sweepstakes NEED NOT be entered in any other class at this show. Entry fee is \$18.00. Write VETERAN SWEEPSTAKES in the "Additional Class" space and state the AGE DIVISION.

### **CLASSIFICATION ~ VETERAN SWEEPSTAKES CLASSES**

The following age division classes are offered for both Dogs and Bitches:  
*7 years and under 10 years; 10 years and under 13 years; 13 years and older*

### **DIVISION OF SWEEPSTAKES STAKES ~ PUPPY & VETERAN**

35% of the fees are retained by SCIHG to help defray the expenses of these classes. The remainder is divided as follows:

First Place ~ 40%; Second Place ~ 30%; Third Place ~ 20%; and Fourth Place ~ 10%.

*All prize money is paid in the ring to the person handling the dog.*

*Undistributed prize money due to absentees is retained by the Club.*

## **NATIONAL OWNER HANDLED SERIES**

### **A Rosette for Best Owner-Handler will be presented.**

The AKC National Owner-Handled Series will be conducted following Best of Breed judging. All dogs in the BOB competition (including WD & WB) will stay in the ring after the judge makes their placements in BOB competition. The ring steward will ask all professional handlers, household members and current assistants to professional handler to leave the ring and then the judge will then select the Best Owner-Handled (BOH). The dog and its owner will continue to accrue points for any group placements or Bests in Show.

The top-ranked dogs from the AKC National Owner-Handled Series are posted on the [AKC National Owner-Handled Series Points Ranking](#) page. Rankings of the dogs competing in the Series are compiled based on the Best of Breed, Group, and Best in Show placements in this specific Series competition (See [Point Schedule](#)). The end of year competition for the AKC National Owner-Handled Series will be held in conjunction with the AKC/Eukanuba show in December. Dogs that finished ranked in the top ten (plus ties) for their breed during the qualifying period will be invited to compete in the competition. Dogs exhibited by professional handlers on the day of the event are not eligible for this competition. Dogs exhibited by current assistants and household members of a professional handler on the day of the event are not eligible to enter this competition.

**Professional handlers** are defined as any person who belongs or has belonged to a professional handlers' organization, distributed rate cards, or otherwise advertised or represented themselves as handling dogs for pay within the last five years.

### BEST OF BREED COMPETITION

The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record. Dogs which according to their owners records have completed the requirements for a championship but whose championships are unconfirmed. The entry and showing of dogs whose championships are unconfirmed is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where a dog completed the requirements for a championship according to the owner's records. If, at the end of the 90 day period, the championship of a dog has not been confirmed by AKC, no further entries of the dog for Best of Breed competition are to be made until its championship has been confirmed by AKC.

### GRAND CHAMPION SELECT

When quality warrants, after Best of Breed and Best of Opposite Sex are awarded, a Select Dog (SD) and Select Bitch (SB) may be chosen from the remaining Champions (Non Regular Class winners that are Champions and Qualify for BOB are eligible) - (WD or WB are not eligible) (AKC Dog Show Rules, Chapter 3, Section 14, Effective 5-12-10)

### AWARDS OF MERIT

The Southern California Ibizan Hound Clubs allows up to two awards (a Rosette) to be presented in addition to Best of Breed and Best of Opposite Sex in recognition of an exceptional Ibizan Hound that was under consideration for Best of Breed or Best of Opposite Sex. The judge may at his/her discretion, award all or none of the rosettes.

### NON-REGULAR CLASSES INVOLVING SINGLE DOG ENTRIES

*Winners from these classes are eligible for Best of Breed Competition.*

### VETERAN CLASS

**\*Veteran Dog Class      \*Veteran Bitch Class**

*A class for dogs and a class for bitches that are 7 years of age or older.*

***\*Chapter 11, Section 8: of the "Rules Applying to Dog Shows" provides that a neutered male may be entered as a Veteran Dog in the Veteran Dog Class and a spayed bitch may be entered as a Veteran Bitch in the Veteran Bitch Class."***

### LURE COURSING CLASS

**Lure Coursing Dog Class      Lure Coursing Bitch Class**

Dogs & Bitches must have a field championship in AKC of ASFA and be at least 1 year old. The Winner of the lure coursing class is eligible to compete in Best of Breed Competition, therefore they may not have any breed disqualifications because WINNERS of the above classes will compete for Best of Breed. All entrants MUST also meet ALL American Kennel Club requirements for Non-Regular Classes involving single dog entries.

## ADDITIONAL RULES

1. Entries must reach the superintendent by Noon, Wednesday December 23, 2020 PT. Fees should accompany entries. This club and/or its superintendent assume no responsibility for wrong or incomplete information given on the entry blank by the owner or agent of the owner. This club and its superintendents assume no responsibility for the owner or owner's agents entering a dog in a class in which the dog is not eligible to compete, or for entering the same dog twice.
2. Returned Checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. The Superintendent will add a collection fee to the amount of each returned check and declined credit card. Subsequent returned checks for the same exhibitors may result in their being put on a CASH ONLY basis. The returned check or declined credit card MUST BE MADE GOOD by cash or money order BEFORE the dog will be allowed in the ring.
3. Exhibitors' Identification tickets and judging programs will be mailed to the address given on the entry blank. If not received within a reasonable time prior to the show, notify the superintendent. Tickets returned by the Post Office marked 'undeliverable' will be held at the Superintendent's Office. PLEASE BRING YOUR IDENTIFICATION TICKETS TO THE SHOW.
4. During the hours of judging owners are to be on call, and have their dogs ready to bring into the judging ring promptly, in order that the judging will not be delayed. Dogs need only be present for their judging. Dogs not needed for further judging may be excused. It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to have his dog ready to be shown and at the entrance of the judging ring when the steward calls for the class. Owners of dogs or the handlers of the dogs alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging rings. This means it is not the responsibility of the ring steward, nor of any agent of the show-giving club to locate any dog, its owner or handler, when the dog's presence is needed in a judging ring. It should be understood by every exhibitor and handler that waiting for dogs to be brought into the ring is a courtesy extended to the owner or handler of the dog. There is no rule of this club or of The American Kennel Club that requires a judge to wait for an owner or handler to bring his dog into the ring. Show hours 7 a.m. to 9:00 p.m.
5. Exhibitors are admonished to make themselves familiar with the agreement of the American Kennel Club, referred to on the reverse side of the entry blanks that accompany this premium list. Rule books are available online at [www.akc.org](http://www.akc.org).
6. The club, its superintendents or their employees will not be responsible for the loss of or damage to any dog exhibited, whether the result of accident or other causes and in addition assumes no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by an exhibitor or handler. It is distinctly understood that every dog at this show is in the care and custody and control of his owner or handler during the entire time the dog is on the show premises.
7. No grooming tables, pens or exhibitor setups will be allowed in the aisles and all grooming must be done away from the judging ring in areas specified by the club.
8. Entry fees shall NOT be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, sick, lame, excused by veterinarian or judge, barred from competition by action of the Bench Show Committee, or because the dog is ineligible to compete due to being entered incorrectly. There is no refund of entry fee for duplicate entry. There will be a \$4.00 fee charged for cancellation of entry prior to closing of entries.
9. There is no provision offered for unentered dogs at this show.
10. Declination of Entries. The Southern California Ibizan Hound Club may decline any entries for cause and may refuse to receive or may remove any dog on account of disease, viciousness or other causes, and no one shall have any claim or recourse against the Kennel Club or any official thereof.
11. If, because of riots, civil disturbances or other acts beyond the control of the management, it is impossible to open or complete the show, no refund of entry will be made.
12. Do not leave any dogs in closed vehicles.
13. Dogs which according to their owners' records have completed the requirements for a championship after the closing of entries for the show but whose championships are unconfirmed, may be transferred from one of the regular classes to the Best of Breed or Variety Competition, provided this transfer is made by the Superintendent at least one half hour prior to the start of the earliest Conformation judging at the Show.
14. Junior Handlers who win a third Novice Class after the Closing of entries for a show may transfer their entry from the Novice Class to the Open Class provided that this transfer is made by the Superintendent at least one half-hour prior to the scheduled start of the earliest conformation judging or one half-hour prior to the scheduled start of Junior Showmanship judging at the Show, whichever is earlier.
15. No practicing allowed in rings at any time.
16. Parents and/or guardians are responsible for the actions of their children.
17. Bitches in season are ineligible to compete in trials. To receive a refund, a veterinarian's letter needs to be received by the Superintendent no later than one half hour prior to the start of the first class in the trial. There will be a \$4.00 fee charged for bitch in season cancellations.
18. By attending this event, you and any guests acknowledge that an inherent risk of exposure to COVID-19 exists in any public place where people are present and agree not to hold the superintendent liable for any illness or injury.
19. By attending this event, you and any guests voluntarily assume all risks related to exposure to COVID-19 and agree not to hold Jack Bradshaw Dog Shows, its owners, employees, or volunteers liable for any illness or injury.

## ***Suggested Best Practices for the Well-Being of Dog Sport Participants***



### ***General Practices***

1. Clubs, officials and participants are required to follow state, local and facility guidelines that apply to the area and site where the event is held.
2. Practice social distancing consistent with guidelines in effect at the time of the event. Avoid congregating to the extent possible.
3. Consider wearing masks when in close proximity to others. Clubs should provide masks if desired for officials, judges and volunteers.
4. Consider wearing disposable or washable gloves.
5. Wash hands as frequently as possible. Have disinfecting spray at bathroom facilities for people to spray door handles (or anything else they touch). Consider hiring bathroom attendants to maintain maximum cleanliness.
6. If you utilize portable toilets, please ask for a hand washing station(s) to be delivered as well.
7. Avoid shaking hands, hugging, or other physical contact.
8. Avoid touching dogs that are not your responsibility.
9. Avoid common use pens/pencils – bring your own.
10. Disinfect surfaces in common use areas as often as possible (tables, chairs, doorknobs, etc.) Clubs and facilities may consider not providing chairs.
11. Meals - Avoid or stagger group lunches/dinners if possible.
12. Vendors should follow retail guidelines for the area.
13. Parking – Park with sufficient distance between vehicles if possible. If there is a parking fee, ask exhibitors to bring exact change.
14. Indoor show sites should work with facilities to have as many entrance/exits points open as possible. Hand sanitizer should be available at every entrance to the site and at multiple locations within the site.
15. Parking/unloading staff should wear masks and sanitize their hands following the assistance of each individual.
