### NON-REGULAR CLASSES, INVOLVING SINGLE DOG ENTRIES

Veteran 7 & under 10 years, 10 & under 12 years; 12 year & older (classes divided by sex)

### **BEST OF BREED COMPETITION**

"The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition. Dogs that are Champions of Record. Dogs which according to their owner's records have completed the requirements for a championship but whose championships are unconfirmed. The entry and showing of dogs whose championships are unconfirmed is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where a dog competed the requirements for a championship according to the owner's records. If, at the end of the 90-day period, the championship of a dog has not been confirmed by the American Kennel Club, no further entries of the dog for Best of Breed competition are to be made until its championship has been confirmed by the AKC."

### NON-REGULAR CLASSES. INVOLVING MULTIPLE DOG ENTRIES

**Stud Dog Class:** For dogs that have sired two dogs or bitches entered in this show. The award will be based on the merits of the get. The owner of the stud dog need not be the owner of the get. As the judge's decision in this class will be based on the merits of more than one dog or bitch, no one of the dogs or bitches making up the entry judged first in the class, will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed by virtue of having won this class. The Stud Dog must appear in the ring with his get and be entered in the Stud Dog Class.

**Brood Bitch Class:** For bitches that have whelped two dogs or bitches entered in this show. The award will be based on the merits of the produce. The owner of the brood bitch need not be the owner of the produce. As the judge's decision in this class will be based on the merit of more than one dog or bitch, no one of the dogs or bitches making up the entry judged first in the class will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed by virtue of having won this class. The Brood Bitch must appear in the ring with her produce and be entered in the Brood Bitch Class.

### **BEST PUPPY**

Best Puppy will be selected from the Puppy Class winners (6-9, 9-12) following the judging of Best of Breed & Award of Merit Competition. Only dogs not defeated in a Puppy Class are eligible to compete.

### **BEST BRED BY EXHIBITOR**

Best Bred By Exhibitor will be selected from the Bred By Exhibitor Class winners following the judging of Best of Breed & Award of Merit Competition. Only dogs not defeated in the Bred By Class are eligible to compete.

### **AWARDS OF MERIT**

Five Award of Merits may be presented in addition to Best of Breed, Best of Opposite Sex and AKC Select Awards. The Judge may at his or her discretion, award all or none of the Rosettes.

### **SWEEPSTAKES**

### **PUPPY SWEEPSTAKES**

Open to all Whippets at least six months of age and under eighteen months of age on the date of the show, who are <u>NOT</u> Champions of Record. Champions of Record are <u>not</u> eligible to compete. Each Whippet must be entered in a regular class with the entry made at the same time and on the same form as the regular entry with Sweepstakes Class denoted in the "Additional Class" space on the entry form.

**CLASSES:** Puppy Sweepstakes divided by sex: 6 & under 9 mos.; 9 & under 12 mos.; 12 & under 15 mos.; 15 & under 18 mos.

**PRIZES:** Entry Fees for Sweepstakes will be distributed as follows: First - 25%; Second - 20%; Third - 15%; Fourth - 10%. Thirty Percent (30%) will be retained by the AWC for expenses. Best in Sweepstakes & Best of Opposite Sex in Sweepstakes will receive a handmade crate pad by Donna O'Toole.

### **VETERAN SWEEPSTAKES**

Sweepstakes classes are open to all Whippets, who, on the day of the show, will be at least 7 years of age. All entries in the Sweepstakes may or may not be entered in a regular class at this show. Sweepstakes classes will be judged prior to the regular breed classes. Indicate "Sweepstakes" and age division on the regular entry form under additional classes.

**CLASSES:** The following age division classes are offered for both Dogs and Bitches: 7 & under 10 years; 10 years & under 12 years; 12 years & older

### **PARKING**

DAY OF SHOW PARKING – Day of show parking will be provided at The Queen Mary Events Park. Day of show parking is \$15 and the parking attendant will collect the fee upon entering the parking lot. The oversized vehicle parking is \$35 per day. Motorhome parking fees are listed below and said motorhomes will be directed to the overnight parking area as their fees are required to be paid in advance (see below). There are no in/out privileges with the exception of motorhomes. VALET PARKING is also available for an additional fee once you have purchased your parking ticket at the gate. After you pay your \$15 parking fee, enter the parking lot and follow the signs to valet parking if you so desire.

NOTE: NO GROOMING ALLOWED IN DAY-OF-SHOW PARKING AREA.

PLEASE REFER TO YOUR JUDGING PROGRAM FOR ADDITIONAL INFORMATION. Unloading will be allowed only in the area designated for such.

**RESERVED OVERNIGHT PARKING** - There are a <u>limited number of spaces available for overnight parking.</u> All vehicles must be entirely self-contained and operate on their own power.

Reservations must be received by June 13, 2013. If you wish to park next to someone specific, please send your reservations together, or arrive together. Overnight parking is available & THE CREW will begin parking motor homes as follows: Thu., June 27 – 10 AM–8 PM; Fri., June 28 – 10 AM–6 PM; Sat., June 29 - 7 AM-9AM. All exhibitors must vacate the grounds by 9 AM, Monday, July 1, 2013. Exhibitors requiring Sunday night stay must include O/N parking fee.

**RULES** -The overnight parking area is a privilege extended by LBKC. The club reserves the right to withdraw this privilege from any person who feels that he or she cannot abide by the rules and instructions given or resorts to abusive language and/or other tactics. Any infractions will be referred to the Bench Committee for appropriate action. Trailers and tow units will be required to be unhitched and parked in a separate parking space. The cost of parking for these vehicles is the same as day of show parking. All vehicles and pens must be confined to a 20 x 35 foot area. You may purchase additional area if necessary. All vehicles must be self-contained and operate on their own power. There will be no water or power hook-ups. Exhibitors are responsible for clean up of their parking spaces.

### **ADDITIONAL RULES**

- 1. Entries must reach the Superintendent, Jack Bradshaw, 5434 East Olympic Boulevard, Los, Angeles CA, 90022, by Noon, Wednesday June 12, 2013 PT. Fees should accompany entries. These clubs and their Superintendents assume no responsibility for wrong or incomplete information given on the entry blank by the owner or agents of the owner. These clubs and its Superintendents assume no responsibility for entry by the owner or owner's agents of a dog in a class in which the dog is not eligible to compete or for entering the same dog twice.
- 2. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. The Superintendent will add a collection fee to the amount of each returned check. Subsequent returned checks for the same exhibitors may result in their being put on a CASH ONLY basis. The returned check MUST BE MADE GOOD by cash or money order BEFORE the dog will be allowed in the ring.
- 3. Exhibitors' identification tickets and judging programs will be mailed to the address given on the entry blank. If not received within a reasonable time prior to the show, notify the Superintendent. Tickets returned by the Post Office marked 'undeliverable' will be held at the Superintendent's Office. PLEASE BRING YOUR IDENTIFICATION TICKETS TO THE SHOW. Regardless of ownership, two admission tickets will be sent for each dog entered.
- 4. During the hours of judging owners are to be on call, and have their dogs ready to bring into the judging ring promptly in order that the judge will not be delayed. Dogs need only be present for their judging. Dogs not needed for further judging may be excused. It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to have his or her dog ready to be shown and at the entrance of the judging ring when the steward calls for the class. Owners of dogs or the handlers of the dogs alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging rings. It is not the responsibility of the ring steward, nor of any agent of the show-giving club to locate any dog, its owner or handler when the dog's presence is needed in a judging ring. It should be understood by every exhibitor and handler that waiting for dogs to be brought into the ring is a courtesy extended to the owner or handler of the dog. There is no rule of this club nor of The American Kennel Club that requires a judge to wait for an owner or handler to bring his dog into the ring. Show hours 8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m.
- 5. Trophies and prizes will be awarded in the judging ring before the completion of the judging of the breed and the Superintendent's office should be advised at once in the event of any discrepancy. All trophies must be claimed the day of the show. None will be mailed.
- 6. Exhibitors are admonished to make themselves familiar with the agreement of the American Kennel Club, referred to on the reverse side of the entry blanks that accompany this premium list. Rulebooks are available online at www.akc.org
- 7. The club, its Superintendents and their employees will not be responsible for loss of or damage to any dog exhibited, whether as the result of accident or for any other cause and no responsibility is assumed for any loss, damage or injury sustained by an exhibitor or handler. It is distinctly understood that every dog at this show is in the care and custody and control of its owner or handler during the entire time the dog is on the show premises.
- 8. No crates, crates with carts, grooming tables, nor exercise pens will be allowed in the aisles. Setups, crates, equipment, etc. are to be in designated areas only, except as otherwise specifically authorized by the Show Chair, and will not be allowed in any other areas.
- 9. Entry fees shall NOT be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, sick, lame, excused by veterinarian or judge, barred from competition by action of the Bench Show Committee, or because the dog is ineligible to compete due to being entered incorrectly. There is no refund of any entry fee for a duplicate entry. There will be a \$2.00 fee charged for cancellation of an entry prior to closing of entries.
- 10. There is no provision offered for un-entered dogs at this show.
- 11. Declination of Entries. The American Whippet Club may decline any entries for cause and may refuse to receive or may remove any dog on account of disease, viciousness or other causes, and no one shall have any claim or recourse against the Kennel Clubs or any official thereof.
- 12. If, because of riots, civil disturbances or other acts beyond the control of these clubs, or management, it is impossible to open or complete the show, no refund of entry will be made.
- 13. Do not leave any dogs in closed vehicles.
- 14. Dogs which according to their owners' records have completed the requirements for a championship after the closing of entries for the show but whose championships are unconfirmed, may be transferred from one of the regular classes to the Best of Breed or Variety Competition, provided this transfer is made by the Superintendent at least one half-hour prior to the start of the earliest conformation judging at the show.
- 15. Junior Handlers who win a third Novice Class after the closing of entries may transfer their entry from the Novice Class to the Open Class provided that this transfer is made by the Superintendent at least one half-hour prior to the scheduled start of the earliest conformation judging or one half-hour prior to the start of Junior Showmanship judging at the show, whichever is earlier.
- 16. No alcohol is allowed on the grounds.
- 17. No practicing allowed in rings at any time.
- 18. Parents and/or guardians are responsible for the actions of their children.

- 2. The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.
- 3. (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e, age division, color division, weight division.
- 4. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his name.
