Best of Breed Competition

For dogs that are Champions of Record, and for dogs, which according to their owners' records have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The entry and showing of dogs whose championships are unconfirmed is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship according to the owner's records.

Select Dog – Select Bitch Competition

The following categories of dogs are entered in this competition: 1. Dogs that are Champions of Record competing in Best of Breed or Variety class. 2. Dogs transferred to Best of Breed/Variety class which according to their owners' records have completed the requirements for a championship but whose championships are unconfirmed. 3. Champions that win Non-Regular classes and become eligible for Best of Breed competition. (Altered or spayed CH veteran class winners at independent specialties are eligible.) 4. Winners Dog and Winners Bitch are not eligible for Grand Champion Competition. At the judge's discretion, Grand Champion Points may be awarded to 1. Best of Breed or Variety, 2. Best of Opposite Sex, 3. Select Dog, 4. Select Bitch. Grand Champion competition will not continue beyond Best of Breed competition, and in breeds that are divided into varieties, Grand Champion competition will not continue beyond Best of Variety competition.

Judge's Award of Merit

After awarding Best of Breed, Best of Winners, and Best of Opposite Sex, the judge may present Awards of Merit up to 10% of the exhibits competing in the Best of Breed class that are, in his/her opinion, outstanding specimens of the breed. Best of Breed, Best of Winners and Best of Opposite Sex are not eligible.

Non-Regular Classes Involving Multiple Dog Entries

Stud Dog Class – For Stud Dogs and two of their Get. Stud Dogs must be entered in the Stud Dog Class, and must be shown in the ring with their Get. Get only to be judged, based upon the merits of the Get. Get must be entered in a Regular Class, Best of Breed, or other Non-Regular Class.

Brood Bitch Class – Same as Stud Dog Class, substitute "Brood Bitches" for "Stud Dogs" and "Produce" for Get. As the judge's decision in this class will be based on the merits of more than one dog or bitch, no one dog or bitch making up the entry judged first in the class, will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed by virtue of having won this class.

Special Awards

Best Veteran Competition: Following the conclusion of Best of Breed and the Judge's Award of Merit, the winners of the Veteran Dog and Veteran Bitch Classes will compete for Best Veteran.

Best Puppy Competition: Following the conclusion of the Best Veteran Competition, the winners of the Puppy Dog and Puppy Bitch classes will compete for Best Puppy.

JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP COMPETITION

NOVICE Class: For boys and girls 9 years and under 18 years old on the day of the Show who, at the time entries close, have not won three (3) First Places, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

OPEN Class: For boys and girls 9 years and under 18 years old on the day of the Show who, at the time entries close, have won three (3) First Places, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

MASTER Class: This class will be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years on the day of the show, and who have won the 10 first place wins in an Open class with competition to be eligible to enter the Limited C lass Competition. The calendar for this class will be November 1 – October 31 of the following year. All Juniors meeting the criteria for this class are required to enter the Master Class and may change their entry the day of the show if entries have already closed. Once the eligibility time frame for that year has passed all participants return to the Open Class to complete for the following year.

Each dog handled in a Junior Showmanship Class must be entered in one of the Breed or Obedience Classes at the show, or must be entered for Junior Showmanship only. However, a dog may be substituted. Such substitution must be accompanied by an official AKC entry form. All such substitutions must be made one half-hour prior to the judging of any Junior Showmanship Classes at the show. Each dog must be owned or co-owned by the Junior Handler or by the Junior Handler's father, mother, brother, sister, uncle, aunt, grandfather or grandmother, including step and half relations or by a member of the Junior Handler's household. Every dog entered for Junior Showmanship must be eligible to compete in Dog Shows or Obedience Trials. A dog that has been rejected, dismissed, or excused by the veterinarian for the protection of the other dogs at the show or the protection of the dog excused may not be handled in Junior Showmanship.

Junior Handlers who win a third Novice Class with competition present after the closing of entries for a show may transfer their entry from the Novice Class to the Open Class provided that this transfer is made by the Superintendent at least one half-hour prior to the scheduled start of any regular conformation judging or one half-hour to the scheduled start of Junior Showmanship judging at the show, whichever is earlier.

Winning of first place in an Open Class at this show may qualify or count toward qualification for entry in certain future limited Junior Showmanship Classes. For information on eligibility requirements for limited Junior Showmanship Classes which have been approved to date by AKC go online at akc.org. Junior Handlers must include their AKC Junior Handler identification number on the entry blank. You may obtain your number by calling the AKC Event Records Department (919) 816-3776. Notice: Be sure all information for Junior Showmanship Classes is entered on the front and back of the entry form.

Sweepstakes Guidelines

Handler: The handler of the Sweepstakes exhibit must be either the owner, co-owner, breeder or member of their immediate family or legal domestic partner as they are listed on file with the American Kennel Club as of the closing date for the show for which the Sweepstakes entry is being made. Immediate family is defined as husband, wife, mother, father, brother, sister, son, daughter. Stepchildren and legal wards are also included in this definition. In-laws and grandchildren are not considered to be immediate family members. No other individual may take the entry into the ring during judging or check-in.

The following individuals are excluded from showing an exhibit in sweepstakes unless they are the SOLE owner registered with the AKC or co-own the entry with a member of their immediate family as defined above or a legal domestic partner:

- Any individual listed as an agent on any dog in any regular or non-regular class
- Any individual with an Agent number including, but not limited to an AKC Registered Handler Number or Professional Handlers Association (PHA) number.

To avoid confusion or question, it is recommended that a photocopy of the registration certificate be included with the entry for a co-owned exhibit.

Disabled or physically challenged handlers are encouraged to show their own dogs and every effort will be made to accommodate them. Some things which might be done to assist them are: making sure the ring gate opening is wide enough for a wheel chair; making sure the surface is as level and smooth as possible; placing slower handlers at the end of the line or having them gait their dogs together; allowing someone else to push an exhibitor's wheelchair, providing they do not handle the dog; making sure stewards and judges face a handler who is hearing impaired when speaking to them; permitting the use of crutches or canes.

Best in Sweepstakes Class. It is required that the same person who showed the dog to a first place in a Sweepstakes class will also show the dog in the Best in Sweepstakes class. However, if that person should have more than one dog in the Best in Sweepstakes class, someone else is permitted to show the additional winner. That person should meet the handler definitions above. Only in cases where there is not another owner, co-owner, breeder or co-breeder, should another person take the dog into the Best in Sweeps class. It is understood that there would be no financial benefit to that individual.

Individuals who have an AKC Handler number, a PHA number or are listed as an agent on any dog in the regular or non-regular classes may not show a sweepstakes entrant unless they are the sole owner registered with the AKC or co-own the entry with a member of their immediate family (as defined above) or a legal domestic partner.

Prize Money

The Distribution of prize money will be by the following schedule of the percent of the entry in each class:

35 % Host Club to cover expenses 20 % Best in Sweepstakes 15% First Place in each class 5% Third Place in each class

15 % Best of Opposite Sex to Best in Sweepstakes
7.5% Second Place in each class
2.5% Fourth Place in each class

Please note: A **refund** of all but \$ 3.00 of the entry fee will be made to any exhibitor who has a bitch entered in the obedience/rally trial who comes into season after the close of entries. To receive a refund, certification from a veterinarian must be presented to the superintendent no later than one-half hour before the event on the day that the dog is entered. Move-Ups will be allowed as per AKC Regulations.

(Variety) if you are entering a dog of breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).
- 2. The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.
- 3. (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e, age division, color division, weight division.
- 4. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to the AKC. (For complete rules, refer to Chapter 11, Section 3.)
- 5. Mixed Breed dogs entering classes for Agility, Obedience, and Rally trials should mark Breed as AKC Canine Partners Listed Dog "All-American Dog/Mixed Breed." Variety, Breeder, Sire, Dam information shall remain blank for mixed breed entrants.
