NON-REGULAR CLASSES, INVOLVING SINGLE DOG ENTRIES

Dual Champions Dogs or Bitches AM EVENT ONLY - The Dual Champion class is open to dogs and bitches that have achieved the AKC Conformation and Field Trial Championships. Winners from these classes will be eligible to compete for Best of Variety if otherwise undefeated on the day of the show.

Field Trial Dogs or Bitches AM EVENT ONLY – The Field Trial class is open to dogs and bitches that have placed in an AKC member or licensed Field Trial. . Winners from these classes will be eligible to compete for Best of Variety if otherwise undefeated on the day of the show.

Note: Neutered dogs and spayed bitches are eligible for entry in Veteran, Dual Champion and Field Trial classes and by virtue of winning the classes, may compete for Best of Variety.

Veteran Dogs and Bitches - For dogs/bitches 7 years of age and older.

BEST OF BREED (VARIETY) COMPETITION

Best of Breed (Variety) Competition - "The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition. Dogs that are Champions of Record. Dogs which according to their owner's records have completed the requirements for a championship but whose championships are unconfirmed. The entry and showing of dogs whose championships are unconfirmed is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where a dog completed the requirements for a championship according to the owner's records. If, at the end of the 90-day period, the championship of a dog has not been confirmed by the American Kennel Club, no further entries of the dog for Best of Breed competition are to be made until its championship has been confirmed by the AKC."

NON-REGULAR CLASSES, INVOLVING MULTIPLE DOG ENTRIES

Stud Dog Class AM EVENT ONLY- For dogs that have sired two dogs or bitches entered in this show. The award will be based on the merits of the get.

The owner of the stud dog need not be the owner of the get. As the judge's decision in this class will be based on the merits of more than one dog or bitch, no one of the dogs or bitches making up the entry judged first in the class, will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed by virtue of having won this class. The Stud Dog must appear in the ring with his get and be entered in the Stud Dog Class.

Brood Bitch Class AM EVENT ONLY – Same as Stud Dog, except for the following two changes: substitute "Brood Bitch" for "Stud Dog" and substitute "Produce" for "Get".

SPECIAL AWARDS

Awards of Merit: At the Judge's discretion, the San Diego Dachshund Club offers Awards of Merit to the quality Dachshunds that are in serious competition for the top awards. It is entirely the Judge's decision whether or not to give all of the available Awards of Merit, some of, or none at all. Awards of Merit available in each variety are determined by the number competing in its BOV competition as follows: 6-8 competing in BOV competition = 1 Award of Merit, 9-12 competing in BOV competition = 2 Awards of Merit, over 12 competing on BOV = 3 Awards of Merit

BEST PUPPY IN PUPPY CLASSES AM EVENT ONLY : Best Puppy will be selected from the puppy class winners from each variety following the judging of Best of Breed Competition. If Winner Dog or Winners Bitch is selected from the Class, it is automatically Best Puppy of its sex. If Winners Dog or Winners Bitch is not from the Puppy Class and Reserve Winners Dog or Reserve Reserve Winners Bitch is from the Puppy Class then Reserve Winners Dog or Reserve Winners Bitch is automatically Best Puppy of its sex. Best Male Puppy and Best Female Puppy will compete for Best Puppy in Classes after Best of Breed Competition. If Best of Breed is from the Puppy Classes then it is automatically Best in Puppy Classes.

BEST IN BRED BY EXHIBITOR CLASSES AM EVENT ONLY: First in Bred By Exhibitor Dog Classes and first in Bred By Exhibitor Bitch Classes (all coats) will compete for Best Bred By Exhibitor following the Best Puppy Competition. If Best of Winners or Best of Variety is from the Bred By Exhibitor Class it is automatically Best Bred by Exhibitor

BEST OPEN MINIATURE AM EVENT ONLY: First in Open Miniature Dog Classes and First in Open Miniature Bitch Classes (all coats) will compete for Best Open Miniature following Best Bred By Exhibitor Classes. If Best of Winners or Best of Variety is from the Open Miniature Classes then it is automatically the Best Open Miniature.

PARADE OF VETERANS AM EVENT ONLY: The Parade of Veterans is open to all Dachshunds who, on the day of the show, are seven (7) years of age or older. An AKC Official Entry Form must be completed and Parade of Veterans indicated under additional classes. Parade of Veterans entrants need not be entered in another class at this show. This is a non-competitive class. Participants receive a Red and Gold Rosette with the dogs name printed on it. Entry fee is \$10.00.

AMATEUR OWNER HANDLER & BRED BY EXHIBITOR CLASS ELIGIBILITY

Amateur Owner Handler Class Eligibility: SECTION 7. (effective as of 1/1/2009) The Amateur-Owner-Handler class shall be for dogs that are at least six months of age that are not champions. Dogs must be handled in the class by the registered owner of the dog. This class is restricted to exhibitors who have not, at any point in time, been a professional handler, AKC approved conformation judge, or employed as an assistant to a professional handler. Additionally, members of the immediate family or household of a current professional handler are ineligible for this class (as defined in Chapter 11, section 13). Professional handlers are defined as any person who belongs or has belonged to a professional handlers' organization, distributed rate cards, or otherwise advertised or represented themselves as handling for pay.

BRED-BY-EXHIBITOR CLASS ELIGIBILITY: 1) Six months of age or older as of the first day of the show, 2) All dogs entered in the Bred By Exhibitor Class must be individually registered with the AKC as of the date of the closing for the show, 3) The person handling the dog must be a breeder of record of the dog and owner of record of the dog, 4) No Champions of Record on the date of closing entries for the show, 5) Owned or co-owned by any of the breeders of record as of the date of the closing of entries for the show. Ch.3, Sec. 7 AKC Rules Applying to Dog Shows.

SWEEPSTAKES – AM EVENT ONLY

PUPPY SWEEPSTAKES

The Sweepstakes are open to all Dachshund who, on the day of the show, will be 6 months of age and under 18 months of age. Dogs shown in the Sweepstakes must also be entered in one of the Regular Classes with the regular entry fee and on the official entry form. Indicate “Sweepstakes” (stating class) in the space for “Additional Classes”.

DIVISION OF PRIZE MONEY

30% of the monies are retained by the club. Remaining 70% distributed as follows (rounded off to the nearest dollar)

First Place – 40% of the entry fee in that class
Second Place – 30% of the entry fee in that class
Third Place – 20% of the entry fee in that class
Fourth Place – 10% of the entry fee in that class

VETERAN SWEEPSTAKES

The Veteran Sweepstakes are open to all Dachshund who are seven (7) years of age and older. Dachshunds entered in Veteran Sweepstakes need not be entered in a Regular Class. Dachshunds entered in Veterans Sweepstakes may be spayed or neutered. Veterans shall be judges in one group, seven (7) years and older. Veterans Sweepstakes Classes shall be divided by coat variety and by sex.

DIVISION OF PRIZE MONEY

30% of the monies are retained by the club. Remaining 70% distributed as follows (rounded off to the nearest dollar)

First Place – 40% of the entry fee in that class
Second Place – 30% of the entry fee in that class
Third Place – 20% of the entry fee in that class
Fourth Place – 10% of the entry fee in that class

JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP COMPETITION – AM EVENT ONLY

Novice Junior Class: For Boys and Girls who are at least 9 years old and under 12 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have not won three First Place awards with competition present in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

Novice Intermediate Class: For Boys and Girls who are at least 12 years old and under 15 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have not won three First Place awards with competition present in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

Novice Senior Class: For Boys and Girls who are at least 15 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have not won three First Place awards with competition present in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

Open Junior Class: For Boys and Girls who are at least 9 years old and under 12 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have won three First Place awards with competition present in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

Open Intermediate Class: For Boys and Girls who are at least 12 years old and under 15 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have won three First Place awards with competition present in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

Open Senior Class: For Boys and Girls who are at least 15 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have won three First Place awards with competition present in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

Master Class: This class will be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years on the day of the show, and who have won the 10 first place wins in an Open class with competition to be eligible to enter the Limited C lass Competition. The calendar for this class will be November 1 - October 31 of the following year. All Juniors meeting the criteria for this class are required to enter the Master Class and may change their entry the day of the show if entries have already closed. Once the eligibility time frame for that year has passed all participants return to the Open Class to complete for the following year.

Each dog handled in a Junior Showmanship Class must be entered in one of the Breed or Obedience Classes at the show, or must be entered for Junior Showmanship only. However, a dog may be substituted. Such substitution must be accompanied by an official AKC entry form. All such substitution must be made one half-hour prior to the judging of any Junior Showmanship Classes at the show. Each dog must be owned or co-owned by the Junior Handler or by the Junior Handler's father, mother, brother, sister, uncle, aunt, grandfather or grandmother, including step and half relations or by a member of the Junior Handler's household. Every dog entered for Junior Showmanship must be eligible to compete in Dog Shows or in Obedience Trials. BITCHES IN SEASON ARE NOT ELIGIBLE. A dog that has been excused or disqualified by a Breed Judge or by a Bench Show Committee may still be handled in Junior Showmanship if eligible to compete in Obedience Trials. A dog that has been rejected, dismissed, or excused by the Veterinarian for the protection of the other dogs at the show or for the protection of the dog excused may not be handled in Junior Showmanship. Junior Handlers who win a third Novice Class with competition present after the closing of entries for a show may transfer their entry from the Novice Class to the Open Class provided that this transfer is made by the Superintendent at least one half-hour prior to the scheduled start of any regular conformation judging or one half-hour to the scheduled start of Junior Showmanship judging at the show, whichever is earlier.

Winning of first place in an Open Class at this show may qualify or count toward qualification for entry in certain future limited. Junior Showmanship Classes. For information on eligibility requirements for limited Junior Showmanship Classes which have been approved to date by AKC, go online at www.akc.org.

Junior Handler's must include their AKC Junior Handler identification number on the entry blank.

You may obtain your number by calling the AKC (919) 233-9767.

Notice: Be sure all information for Junior Showmanship Classes is entered on the front and back of the entry form.

This club and its superintendents assume no responsibility for the owner or owner's agents entering a dog in a class in which the dog is not eligible to compete, or for entering the same dog twice.
2. Returned Checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. The Superintendent will add a collection fee to the amount of each returned check and declined credit card. Subsequent returned checks for the same exhibitors may result in their being put on a CASH ONLY basis. The returned check or declined credit card **MUST BE MADE GOOD** by cash or money order **BEFORE** the dog will be allowed in the ring.
3. Exhibitors' Identification tickets and judging programs will be mailed to the address given on the entry blank. If not received within a reasonable time prior to the show, notify the superintendent. Tickets returned by the Post Office marked 'undeliverable' will be held at the Superintendent's Office. **PLEASE BRING YOUR IDENTIFICATION TICKETS TO THE SHOW.**
4. During the hours of judging owners are to be on call, and have their dogs ready to bring into the judging ring promptly, in order that the judging will not be delayed. Dogs need only be present for their judging. Dogs not needed for further judging may be excused. It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to have his dog ready to be shown and at the entrance of the judging ring when the steward calls for the class. Owners of dogs or the handlers of the dogs alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging rings. This means it is not the responsibility of the ring steward, nor of any agent of the show-giving club to locate any dog, its owner or handler, when the dog's presence is needed in a judging ring. It should be understood by every exhibitor and handler that waiting for dogs to be brought into the ring is a courtesy extended to the owner or handler of the dog. There is no rule of this club nor of The American Kennel Club that requires a judge to wait for an owner or handler to bring his dog into the ring. Show hours 7 a.m. to 6:00 p.m.
5. Trophies and prizes will be awarded in the judging ring before the completion of the judging of the breed and the superintendent's office advised at once, in the event of any discrepancy. All trophies must be claimed the day of the show. None will be mailed.
6. Exhibitors are admonished to make themselves familiar with the agreement of the American Kennel Club, referred to on the reverse side of the entry blanks that accompany this premium list. Rulebooks are available online at www.akc.org
7. The club, its superintendents or their employees will not be responsible for the loss of or damage to any dog exhibited, whether the result of accident or other causes and in addition assumes no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by an exhibitor or handler. It is distinctly understood that every dog at this show is in the care and custody and control of his owner or handler during the entire time the dog is on the show premises.
8. No grooming tables, pens or exhibitors setups will be allowed in the aisles and all grooming must be done away from the judging ring in areas specified by the club.
9. Entry fees shall **NOT** be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, sick, lame, excused by veterinarian or judge, barred from competition by action of the Bench Show Committee, or because the dog is ineligible to compete due to being entered incorrectly. There is no refund of entry fee for duplicate entry. There will be a \$2.00 fee charged for cancellation of entry prior to closing of entries.
10. There is no provision offered for unentered dogs at this show.
11. Declination of Entries. The San Diego Dachshund Club may decline any entries for cause and may refuse to receive or may remove any dog on account of disease, viciousness or other causes, and no one shall have any claim or recourse against the Kennel Club or any official thereof.
12. If, because of riots, civil disturbances or other acts beyond the control of the management, it is impossible to open or complete the show, no refund of entry will be made.
13. Do not leave any dogs in closed vehicles.
14. A Recording Fee of 50 cents and an Event Services Fee of \$3.00 will be required at any Licensed or Member Club Show, Obedience Trial or Tracking Test. These fees are to be collected by the Show-giving Club and paid to the American Kennel Club.
15. Dogs which according to their owners' records have completed the requirements for a championship after the closing of entries for the show but whose championships are unconfirmed, may be transferred from one of the regular classes to the Best of Breed or Variety Competition, provided this transfer is made by the Superintendent at least one half hour prior to the start of the earliest Conformation judging at the Show.
16. Parents and/or guardians are responsible for the actions of their children.

4. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed.
