Amateur Owner Handler - _For dogs that are at least six months of age that are not champions. Dogs must be handled in the class by the registered owner of the dog and is limited to exhibitors who have not, at any point in time, been a professional handler, AKC approved conformation judge, or employed as an assistant to a professional handler. Additionally, members of the immediate family or household of a current professional handler are ineligible for this class (as defined in Chapter 11, Section 13). Professional handlers are defined as any person who belongs to a professional handlers' organization, distributed rate cards, or otherwise advertised or represented themselves as handling dogs for pay.

NON-REGULAR CLASSES. INVOLVING SINGLE DOG ENTRIES

Veteran - 7 & under 9 years, 9 years and older (classes divided by sex)

Best of Breed Competition – "The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition. Dogs that are Champions of Record. Dogs which according to their owner's records have completed the requirements for a championship but whose championships are unconfirmed. The entry and showing of dogs whose championships are unconfirmed is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where a dog competed the requirements for a championship according to the owner's records. If, at the end of the 90-day period, the championship of a dog has not been confirmed by the American Kennel Club, no further entries of the dog for Best of Breed competition are to be made until its championship has been confirmed by the AKC."

Select - When quality warrants, after BOV and BOS to BOV are awarded, a Select Dog (SD) and Select Bitch (SB) may be chosen form the remaining Champions (Non Regular Class winners that are Champions and Qualify for BOV are eligible) - (WD or WB are not eligible) (AKC Dog Shows Rules, Chapter 3, Section 14 Effective 5-12-10)

Best Bred By Exhibitor (BBE) and Bred By Exhibitor Class Eligibility - Best BBE will be selected from the First Place Winners of the BBE Dog and BBE Bitch Classes. All dogs entered in the Bred-By Class must be individually registered with the AKC. The person handling the dog must be a breeder of record of the dog and an owner of record of the dog. Family members must be both a breeder and owner of record to exhibit in the class.

NON-REGULAR CLASSES, INVOLVING MULTIPLE DOG ENTRIES

Stud Dog Class - For dogs that have sired two dogs or bitches entered in this show. The award will be based on the merits of the get. The owner of the stud dog need not be the owner of the get. As the judge's decision in this class will be based on the merits of more than one dog or bitch, no one of the dogs or bitches making up the entry judged first in the class, will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed by virtue of having won this class. The Stud Dog must appear in the ring with his get and be entered in the Stud Dog Class.

Brood Bitch Class - For bitches that have whelped two dogs or bitches entered in this show. The award will be based on the merits of the produce. The owner of the brood bitch need not be the owner of the produce. As the judge's decision in this class will be based on the merit of more than one dog or bitch, no one of the dogs or bitches making up the entry judged first in the class will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed by virtue of having won this class. The Brood Bitch must appear in the ring with her produce and be entered in the Brood Bitch Class.

NEW SWEEPSTAKES RULES

SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA SPORTING DOG FANCIERS, INC. – SWEEPSTAKES RULES SWEEPSTAKES CLASS ENTRIES MUST ALSO BE ENTERED IN A REGULAR CLASS.

The Southern California Sporting Dog Fanciers, Inc. Sweepstakes is open to all dogs assigned to the Sporting Group by the American Kennel Club.

ELIGIBILITY: The Sweepstakes will be judged prior to the first set of Regular Show Classes and is open to all Sporting Dogs that will be at least six (6) months of age and not over eighteen (18) months of age on the day of the Show may compete in the Sweepstakes classes.

Champions may be entered in the Sweepstakes.

ENTRIES: As each dog entered in the Sweepstakes MUST also be entered in one of the Regular Breed Classes of the Show, at the regular entry fee, each must be entered as an additional class on the Official A.K.C. entry form in the space titled "Additional Classes" as "Sweepstakes" giving the age division and including the additional fee as listed on the official AKC Entry Form.

SWEEPSTAKES CLASSIFICATION (divided by sex)

6 & under 9 months; 9 & under 12 months

BEST PUPPY IN SWEEPSTAKES at the Breed Level only

12 & under 15 months; 15 & under 18 months

BEST JUNIOR IN SWEEPSTAKES at the Breed Level only

BEST IN SWEEPSTAKES Breed Competition will be selected from Best Puppy in Sweepstakes and Best Junior in Sweepstakes and the Sporting Dog receiving the award of "Best in Sweepstakes in its respective breed is eligible to compete in the Sporting Dog Sweepstakes.

The Sporting Dog Sweepstakes is to be judged before the Sporting Group.

DIVISION OF STAKES

20% of the fees will be reserved for club expenses. 30% of the fees will be reserved for Best in Sweepstakes "Group Competition" 20% for placement 2-4. The remaining 30% will be divided proportionately by the number of entries in each breed and be divided as follows: 15 % Best Puppy in Sweepstakes 15% Best Junior in Sweepstakes

There will be <u>NO</u> monies paid for Best in Sweepstakes at the Breed Level and <u>NO</u> monies paid for class placements. The Sweepstakes prize money will be given to the handler in the ring. Any sweepstake money not awarded will be retained by the Southern California Sporting Dog Fanciers, Inc.

JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP COMPETITION

Novice Junior Class: For Boys and Girls who are at least 9 years old and under 12 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have not won three First Place awards with competition present in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

Novice Intermediate Class: For Boys and Girls who are at least 12 years old and under 15 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have not won three First Place awards with competition present in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

Novice Senior Class: For Boys and Girls who are at least 15 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have not won three First Place awards with competition present in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

Open Junior Class: For Boys and Girls who are at least 9 years old and under 12 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have won three First Place awards with competition present in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

Open Intermediate Class: For Boys and Girls who are at least 12 years old and under 15 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have won three First Place awards with competition present in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

Open Senior Class: For Boys and Girls who are at least 15 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have won three First Place awards with competition present in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

Master Class: This class will be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years on the day of the show, and who have won the 10 first place wins in an Open class with competition to be eligible to enter the Limited Class Competition. The calendar for this class will be November 1 - October 31 of the following year. All Juniors meeting the criteria for this class are required to enter the Master Class and may change their entry the day of the show if entries have already closed. Once the eligibility time frame for that year has passed all participants return to the Open Class to complete for the following year

Each dog handled in a Junior Showmanship Class must be entered in one of the Breed or Obedience Classes at the show, or must be entered for Junior Showmanship only. However, a dog may be substituted. Such substitution must be accompanied by an official AKC entry form. All such substitutions must be made one half-hour prior to the judging of any Junior Showmanship Classes at the show. Each dog must be owned or co-owned by the Junior Handler or by the Junior Handler's father, mother, brother, sister, uncle, aunt, grandfather or grandmother, including step and half relations or by a member of the Junior Handler's household. Every dog entered for Junior Showmanship must be eligible to compete in Dog Shows or in Obedience Trials. BITCHES IN SEASON ARE NOT ELIGIBLE. A dog that has been excused or disqualified by a Breed Judge or by a Bench Show Committee may still be handled in Junior Showmanship if eligible to compete in Obedience Trials. A dog that has been rejected, dismissed, or excused by the Veterinarian for the protection of the other dogs at the show or for the protection of the dog excused may not be handled in Junior Showmanship

Junior Handlers who win a third Novice Class with competition present after the closing of entries for a show may transfer their entry from the Novice Class to the Open Class provided that this transfer is made by the Superintendent at least one half-hour prior to the scheduled start of any regular conformation judging or one half-hour to the scheduled start of Junior Showmanship judging at the show, whichever is earlier.

Winning of first place in an Open Class at this show may qualify or count toward qualification for entry in certain future limited Junior Showmanship Classes. For information on eligibility requirements for limited Junior Showmanship Classes which have been approved to date by AKC.

Junior Handlers must include their AKC Junior Handler identification number on the entry blank. You may obtain your number by calling the AKC Event Records Department (919) 233-9767.

- 1. Entries must reach the Superintendent, Jack Bradshaw, 5434 East Olympic Boulevard, Los, Angeles CA, 90022, by Noon, Wednesday June 12, 2013 PT. Fees should accompany entries. These clubs and their Superintendents assume no responsibility for wrong or incomplete information given on the entry blank by the owner or agents of the owner. These clubs and its Superintendents assume no responsibility for entry by the owner or owners agents of a dog in a class in which the dog is not eligible to compete or for entering the same dog twice.
- 2. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. The Superintendent will add a collection fee to the amount of each returned check. Subsequent returned checks for the same exhibitors may result in their being put on a CASH ONLY basis. The returned check MUST BE MADE GOOD by cash or money order BEFORE the dog will be allowed in the ring.
- 3. Exhibitors' identification tickets and judging programs will be mailed to the address given on the entry blank. If not received within a reasonable time prior to the show, notify the Superintendent. Tickets returned by the Post Office marked 'undeliverable' will be held at the Superintendent's Office. PLEASE BRING YOUR IDENTIFICATION TICKETS TO THE SHOW. Regardless of ownership, two admission tickets will be sent for each dog entered.
- 4. During the hours of judging owners are to be on call, and have their dogs ready to bring into the judging ring promptly in order that the judge will not be delayed. Dogs need only be present for their judging. Dogs not needed for further judging may be excused. It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to have his or her dog ready to be shown and at the entrance of the judging ring when the steward calls for the class. Owners of dogs or the handlers of the dogs alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging rings. It is not the responsibility of the ring steward, nor of any agent of the show-giving club to locate any dog, its owner or handler when the dog's presence is needed in a judging ring. It should be understood by every exhibitor and handler that waiting for dogs to be brought into the ring is a courtesy extended to the owner or handler of the dog. There is no rule of this club nor of The American Kennel Club that requires a judge to wait for an owner or handler to bring his dog into the ring. Show hours 7:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m.
- 5. Trophies and prizes will be awarded in the judging ring before the completion of the judging of the breed and the Superintendent's office should be advised at once in the event of any discrepancy. All trophies must be claimed the day of the show. None will be mailed.
- 6. Exhibitors are admonished to make themselves familiar with the agreement of the American Kennel Club, referred to on the reverse side of the entry blanks that accompany this premium list. Rulebooks are available online at www.akc.org
- 7. The club, its Superintendents and their employees will not be responsible for loss of or damage to any dog exhibited, whether as the result of accident or for any other cause and no responsibility is assumed for any loss, damage or injury sustained by an exhibitor or handler. It is distinctly understood that every dog at this show is in the care and custody and control of its owner or handler during the entire time the dog is on the show premises.
- 8. No crates, crates with carts, grooming tables, nor exercise pens will be allowed in the aisles. Setups, crates, equipment, etc. are to be in designated areas only, except as otherwise specifically authorized by the Show Chair, and will not be allowed in any other areas.
- 9. Entry fees shall NOT be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, sick, lame, excused by veterinarian or judge, barred from competition by action of the Bench Show Committee, or because the dog is ineligible to compete due to being entered incorrectly. There is no refund of any entry fee for a duplicate entry. There will be a \$2.00 fee charged for cancellation of an entry prior to closing of entries.
- 10. There is no provision offered for un-entered dogs at this show.
- 11. Declination of Entries. The Southern California Sporting Dog Fanciers, Inc. may decline any entries for cause and may refuse to receive or may remove any dog on account of disease, viciousness or other causes, and no one shall have any claim or recourse against the Kennel Clubs or any official thereof.
- 12. If, because of riots, civil disturbances or other acts beyond the control of these clubs, or management, it is impossible to open or complete the show, no refund of entry will be made.
- 13. Do not leave any dogs in closed vehicles.
- 14. Dogs which according to their owners' records have completed the requirements for a championship after the closing of entries for the show but whose championships are unconfirmed, may be transferred from one of the regular classes to the Best of Breed or Variety Competition, provided this transfer is made by the Superintendent at least one half-hour prior to the start of the earliest conformation judging at the show.
- 15. Junior Handlers who win a third Novice Class after the closing of entries may transfer their entry from the Novice Class to the Open Class provided that this transfer is made by the Superintendent at least one half-hour prior to the scheduled start of the earliest conformation judging or one half-hour prior to the start of Junior Showmanship judging at the show, whichever is earlier.
- 16. No alcohol is allowed on the grounds.
- 17. Dogs which according to their owners' records have earned an obedience or rally title after the closing of entries for the show may be moved up to the next class, provided this transfer is made in writing and presented to the superintendent at least 30 minutes prior to the start of each trial.
- 18. No practicing allowed in rings at any time.
- 19. Parents and/or guardians are responsible for the actions of their children.

The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.
