BEST OF BREED (VARIETY) COMPETITION

Best of Breed (Variety) Competition - The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition. Dogs that are Champions of Record. Dogs which according to their owner's records have completed the requirements for a championship but whose championships are unconfirmed. The entry and showing of dogs whose championships are unconfirmed is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where a dog completed the requirements for a championship according to the owner's records. If, at the end of the 90-day period, the championship of a dog has not been confirmed by the American Kennel Club, no further entries of the dog for Best of Breed competition are to be made until its championship has been confirmed by the AKC.

Obedience and Rally are not offered at these events. Junior Showmanship is offered only at the Friday concurrent specialty of the Dalmatian Club of Southern California.

COVID-19 PROTOCOLS WILL BE FOLLOWED AT THESE EVENTS AS ADVISABLE

RAMP - At the discretion of the judge, the following breeds may be judged on a ramp through all levels of competition: Finnish Spitz. The following breeds must be judged on a ramp through all levels of conformation competition: Bulldogs, Chinese Shar-Pei, Chow Chows, Keeshonden.

Junior showmanship judges should follow the above.

Ramps may be used in emergency situations to judge any breed. (In all but emergency situations, the exhibitor has no recourse. In an emergency situation, where use of a ramp is not indicated in the premium list, an exhibitor has the option of withdrawing their entry and receiving a refund.) 6/2/21

Sweepstake Rules – Sweepstakes is open to all French Bulldogs at least 6 months of age but under 18 months of age, which are NOT Champions of Record and which have not completed the requirements for championship prior to the closing of entries for this Sweepstakes. Dogs shown in Sweepstakes must also be entered in one of the regular classes. On the regular entry form the Sweepstakes Class with age division should be entered in the space provided for “Additional Classes”.

Classes: 6-9, 9-12, 12-18 divided by sex

Veteran Sweepstakes Rules: Veteran Sweepstakes is open to all French Bulldogs that are 7 years of age or older on the day of the show. Dogs shown in Veteran Sweepstakes may be champions or non-champions. The Veterans Sweepstakes classes will not automatically qualify any winner to go on to a placement in the rest of the show. Neutered dogs & spayed bitches are eligible to compete. Dogs shown in Veteran Sweepstakes need not be entered in one of the regular classes. On the regular entry form the Veteran Sweepstakes Class with the age division should be entered in the space provided for “Additional Classes”. Classes: 7 and under 9 years; 9 years and older

Prize Money 35% of total entry fees in each class are retained to cover expenses. The remainder of the entry fees for each class will be divided as follows: First - 35% Second - 15% Third - 10% Fourth - 5%. Any prize money not awarded for any reason will be retained by the club.

Professional Handlers in Sweepstakes and Veteran Sweepstakes - Dogs they own or co-own can be exhibited, but they cannot handle the dog. Regulations: Dogs that are owned or co-owned by a professional handler may compete in this class but must be handled by a non-professional handler. Professional handlers are defined as any person who belongs or has belonged to a professional handlers' organization, distributed rate cards, or otherwise advertised or represented themselves as handling dogs for pay in the 18 months preceding the show. Dogs may not be exhibited by current assistants or household members of a professional handler.

GROOMING

*****Rules In Force*****

Ringside crating areas are to be used only for the crating of dogs while that breed is being judged. Exhibitors should take up no more space than one crate per dog. Dogs should not be crated in this area more than twenty minutes before the breed is scheduled to be judged and must be removed immediately after that breed judging is finished. There is to be no grooming in the ringside crating area, which means no grooming tables (other than small foldable ringside tables), set ups, exercise pens, dryers, clippers or any other electrical devices that are commonly used in grooming. The only show preparation that is allowed in the ringside crating area is a simple final touch up that can be done while a dog is either in the crate or on top of the crate or ringside table which takes up no more than minimal additional space in this area. Please keep all aisles clear and be considerate of others while in ringside crating areas.

Exhibitors understand and accept that the Show Committee has the right to move a person's dogs and belongings if these rules have been violated or as necessary to accommodate additional exhibitors in a safe and prudent manner.

The judge shall select a Best Junior in Sweepstakes (from 6-9 and 9-12 class winners both sexes) and a Best Senior in Sweepstakes (from 12-15 and 15-18 class winners both sexes), and then from these winners shall select a Best in Sweepstakes.

Veterans Sweepstakes Rules—Entries in Veteran Sweepstakes do not have to be entered in a regular class at this show. Classes are open to dogs that have been spayed or neutered.

Professional handlers may show only dogs they own.

Classes 7-10 years, 10 years and older divided by sex

Prize Money 35% of total entry fees in each class are retained to cover expenses. The remainder of the entry fees for each class will be divided as follows: First - 35% Second - 15% Third - 10% Fourth - 5%. Rounded to the nearest dollar. 4. During the hours of judging owners are to be on call, and have their dogs ready to bring into the judging ring promptly, in order that the judging will not be delayed. Dogs need only be present for their judging. Dogs not needed for further judging may be excused. It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to have his dog ready to be shown and at the entrance of the judging ring when the steward calls for the class. Owners of dogs or the handlers of the dogs alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging rings.
